





NEIGHBOURHOOD TOURS

FORMING NEIGHBOURHOOD TOURS



A) Form an Organising Group

Organise a kickoff meeting with all interested residents to discuss the design and objectives of the tours. Roving Labs can provide initial guidance and resources.

B) Approach Local Hosts

See which of the local businesses, hawkers, schools, social service agencies are keen to host a group, share what they do, and tell stories. Residents themselves can host conversations.


C) Design the Walking Trail

Make sure it is not too long, and have some rest stops for food or drinks. Make sure you have different hosts so that the trails cover a broad variety of local organisations and individuals.

D) Run the Trail, Connect People

The more trails you do, the more you will know the strengths and interests of your local community. You can informally connect people who have shared interests or even offer opportunities to locals to support those who need assistance.
